## **Second Century Campaign Progress**

The Academy and Foundation kicked off our Second Century Campaign at FNCE of 2016 in honor of the Academy's 100 year anniversary, with a member of goal of \$5M and since then, Academy leaders, members, affiliates, DPGs and MIGs have been stepping up to support this effort with significant gifts. As of today, we have raised close to \$4M – or 80% of our goal. This campaign runs through FNCE of 2020 and we are \$1M way from achieving this significant accomplishment.
